WHAT IS OVARIAN CANCER?

Ovarian cancer refers to a group of distinct cancers that originate at or near the ovaries. It is notoriously difficult to detect as signs and symptoms of ovarian cancer are subtle and may be mistakenly attributed to other causes. There is no effective screening test for this disease.

Everyone who is born with ovaries has some risk for this disease. Risk factors include: age, ethnicity, genetic mutations or a family history of certain cancers, BRCA1 and BRCA2 or other gene mutations. and endometriosis.
